Training for Mission

- **Kairos course – 145 church leaders** trained in Kenya, **50%** of them from ACK Embu Diocese with SM Kenya


Impact: Increased awareness and commitments by churches in the FCT to engage UPGs in the Sahel.

While in university, a staff of **Global Activation Ministry (Activate)** regularly visited the campus, teaching students about missions and the strategic need to take the gospel to the world. This led to Rafiki attending the **Ready-2-Run** retreat organized by Activate, where he met Mark, the director of the ministry, who has now become his mentor. Walking closely with Activate, his heart began to burn for Missions.

Formerly, I related with Christ as people told me about Him, but R2R impacted me in personally knowing Christ intimately


I was the boss of my life and everything I had but R2R helped me to realize that all I am and have has been entrusted to me by God for His purpose.
